Post Winter Storm Safety

After a winter storm hits your propane fueled home, look for the following safety signs, power lines standing strong; gas lines and tanks in place and undamaged; chimneys, flue and gas pipes, meters, regulators and vents clear of snow and ice. Clear away ice and snow very carefully. High winds can shift snow and ice creating hazardous situations by covering equipment.
